Supplies to Benefit the Wildlife Rehabilitation Center

- 100mg Thiamine or Vitamin B-1 tablets (to supplement fish-eating bird diets)
- Baby Food (fruit, meat, vegetable)
- Berries (fresh or frozen)
- Bird Seed (mixed, finch, thistle, safflower and sunflower seed)
- Bungee Cords (all sizes)
- Corn (whole kernel or cracked)
- Dish Soap (liquid)
- Duct Tape
- Feather Dusters (used for orphaned waterfowl to snuggle under)
- Fish (any kind, fresh or frozen)
- Gift Cards (Pick N' Save, Outpost Natural Foods, Walgreens, Home Depot)
- Heating Pads (without automatic shut-off)
- Insects (live, freeze-dried or frozen crickets, mealworms, waxworms)
- Lactated Ringer's Solution (expired is OK)
- Latex/Vinyl Exam Gloves (non-sterile)
- Millet Sprays
- Mortar and Pestle
- Peanuts or Mixed Nuts (unsalted, whole or shelled)
- Pedialyte (unflavored)
- Pine Cones
- Puppy Chow
- Squirrel Mix
- Timothy Hay
- Vegetables (fresh or frozen)
- Worms (live earth or redworms)
- Zip Ties
